

## **St. Anthony School Student Classroom Supply List 2011-2012 School Year**

This is a list of supplies that your child should bring to school on August 31, 2011 (Kindergarten on September 6, 2011.)

Please keep in mind that as supplies are depleted during the school year, they will need to be replenished.

IN ADDITION to the items below, each child needs a book bag.

### **GRADE 1 – GRADE 5**
